Area	Details
Main entrance	Clean leaves & debris from gravel bed
Main entrance	Hedge/bush trimming as needed
Main building windows	Wash with vinegar mixture
Modular windows	Wash with vinegar mixture
Parking lot	Clean leaves & debris from base of parking barriers (both sides) and along base of building
Parking lot	Sweep footpath b/w parking barriers and building
Parking lot	Ensure concrete parking barriers along 14th are aligned/properly placed (snowplow and vehicles sometimes move them)
Main entrance	If needed, weed garden/flower bed beside main entrance doors
Lawn b/w parking lot and 14th	Rake out leaves, debris, rocksget it 'mower' ready
Grassy area by portico (where picnic tables are)	Rake out, mow if needed. Whipper-snip along building. Move bike rack and tables out of the way (don't just mow around them)
Whole campus	Clean up garbage: playground, field, shop/bus parking area, behind dumpster (corner 14th & Fulton)everywhere. Winter garbage has accumulated
Whole campus	Whipper-snip any long grass along buildings
Parking lot	Sweep end of parking lot by dumpster.
Shop area	Random lumber and junk outside the shop: The 'rainbow' garbage can should be placed inside the shed.
Along Fulton Avenue	Garbage accumulated between sidewalk and fence. Might have been cleaned up already by elem town clean-up. But please check and clean-up as needed.
Neighborhood / 14th Ave	Check for garbage. Sweep sidewalks.
Portico stairway	Sweep / wash / pressure wash stairs under blue portico. If possible, remove bird nests from skylights/roof.
Front flower bed (near BVCS sign)	check for weeds
Front flower bed (near BVCS sign)	Sweep sidewalk, rake grass in the triangular patch by sign
Front lawn by modular	whipper snip along building as needed

In the shed (attached to shop):

- leaf blower
- whipper snipper
- rakes
- shovels
- wheelbarrow

Please ensure these are returned to shed!

There might be some things that need doing that aren't on this list. If you see something, please take the initiative to look after it.
